LIBRARY CATALOGUE AND ELECTRONIC DATABASES

To find books, journals, and audiovisual materials on your topic, search the library's online **catalogue**. If you are looking for journal articles, search the library's online **journal article indexes & electronic databases**. Use **keywords** to search the online catalogue and/or electronic databases. A keyword is a word or term that best describes the information you are looking for. You can search the library catalogue or an electronic database for either a single keyword or a combination of keywords in order to find articles in an electronic database or books in the online catalogue containing the keyword(s).

Academic Search Premier: Provides coverage for social sciences, humanities, education, computer sciences, arts and literature, medical sciences, and ethnic studies. Citations and full text available. 1984-present. Updated monthly.

CBCA Fulltext Reference: Canadian Business and Current Affairs is a major index for Canadian newspapers, popular & business scholarly journal and popular magazines. 1982– present.

ERIC: Provides coverage to education, educational psychology, physical and special education. 1966-current. Updated quarterly

First Nations Periodicals Index: Contains journals of mainly Canadian Native content. This index is a tool providing access to information about First Nations.

Health Source Nursing Academic Edition: nearly 540 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. Also featured are abstracts and indexing for over 570 journals.

PsychArticles: Psychology fulltext articles from 49-peer-reviewed journals published by the American Psychological Association. 1988-current.

PsychINFO: Psychology and related behavioral and social sciences. 1887-current. Updated monthly

Readers Guide to Periodical Literature: Subjects include popular literature, current events, business, fashion, politics, crafts, food, sports, history & science. 1983-current

Social Science Index: Provides coverage in literature, sociology, anthropology, geography, etc. 1983- present. Updated monthly.

Sociological Abstracts: This database covers the latest research in the fields of sociology, social sciences and related disciplines. Abstracts and enhanced citations are available for over 1640 journals, monographs, conference papers and dissertations 1960-current.
