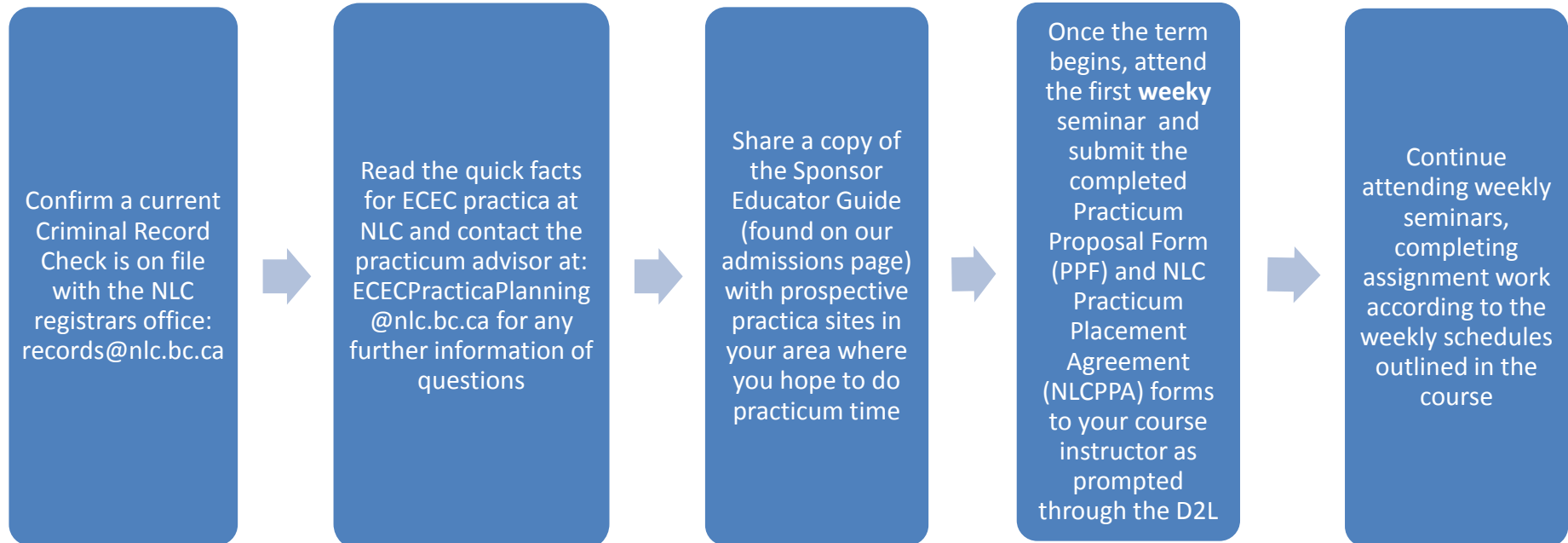


Quick Steps and Facts for Organizing an ECEC practicum at NLC
