Did you know you can access your student account online? Students can now access their unofficial transcript, grades, account summary, class schedule, and tax receipt (T2202A) when it becomes available after February 28th. If you don't have a Web Advisor login, click on “WebAdvisor and Office 365 Login Help” at the bottom left hand side of the page.

Courses on Desire2Learn (D2L)

Courses that you have registered for will be available on D2L on the first day of the course. There you will access the course content, readings, instructor information, teleconference dates, times and toll free phone numbers, etc.

There are two ways to access D2L:

Click on the "D2L Student Login" link on the NLC homepage at: <http://nlc.bc.ca>

Go directly to: <http://d2l.nlc.bc.ca>

Your D2L username is now your 7 digit NLC student ID. For example, '0012345'. Your initial password is your birthdate dd/mm/yy - MUST include the slashes (Ex: 03/26/77)

Please be sure to change your password and keep it recorded in a safe and secure spot. If you lose your password please email jroyer@nlc.bc.ca to have your password reset.

D2L Sandbox

Once you have received an acceptance letter, you will then be required to pay the Materials fee to be given access to the NLC Desire2Learn (D2L) “Sandbox”, which provides students with an informal introduction to the online learning environment. The “Sandbox” name was deliberately chosen as it represents a place to play and explore. It is intended to be self-paced – it is not a course and has no assessed assignments or credit. However, there are a series of basic tasks that will help students to successfully navigate through the key features that will be used in D2L. We hope to “see” you there. 😊
