## BC Hydro Trades and Skilled Training Award

-  Full-time students who normally reside in northeast British Columbia, and who are enrolled full time in one of the following program areas: Aircraft Maintenance Engineering, Automotive Service Technician, Carpentry, Commercial Transport Technician, Cook Training, Early Childhood Education and Care Diploma (part-time students are eligible), Electrician, Heavy Mechanical Trades, Industrial Instrumentation Mechanic, Millwright, Plumber, Practical Nursing, Social Services Worker Diploma, and Welding.
-  Up to 40 awards, with a value of up to \$5,000 per recipient.
-  Tuition and other living expenses (where applicable).
-  BC Hydro Award application, including sections on personal financial information, deadlines Mar 31, Jun 30, Aug 31, Nov 30; 150-200 word cover letter that includes description of education and work experience, financial need, career and educational goals and any volunteer/community involvement.





## Monty Bissett Bursary Fund

-  Full-time student enrolled in any program at the Dawson Creek Campus.
-  Five @ \$2,000 (Tuition Credit).
-  Financial need; letter describing educational and career goals.
-  NLC Foundation application, deadline June 30.





## Canbriam Energy Aboriginal New Student Award

-  Aboriginal student enrolled full-time in any program at the Chetwynd or Fort St. John campus.
-  One \$1,000 award.
-  One-page essay outlining the need for the award and their career goals
-  NLC Foundation application, deadline Sep 20.





## Encana Indigenous Student Award

-  Any northeast BC Indigenous student residing in the Dawson Creek, Fort St. John or Fort Nelson region enrolled in full-time studies at any NLC campus.
-  Six \$1,000 awards.
-  Submit a one-page essay detailing need for the award and describing career aspirations.
-  NLC Foundation application, deadline Sep 20.





## NLC Career and College Preparation Bursary Fund

-  Any student enrolling in part-time or full-time studies in the College and Career Preparation Program at Northern Lights College.
-  100% of books and 100% of program costs.
-  Available to students who have exhausted all other sources of funding for their program costs (e.g. Adult Upgrading Grant) and who show financial need. Students who have previously received this Bursary Funding may apply for continued support, but must have demonstrated successful completion and/or satisfactory progress in their previous course(s) as outlined in the adult upgrading grant guidelines.
-  NLC General Entrance Award Application Form, brief description of the applicant's career and educational goals and a description of their financial need. Deadline continuous.





## NLC Foundation Award of Excellence

-  Secondary school graduate in NLC catchment area who is going on to full-time studies at NLC.
-  One \$3,000 Entrance Award
-  Essay of approximately 300 words outlining community involvement; leadership roles in school or community; extra-curricular activities; future plans and how attending NLC will help those plans; and a community project the student would like to be involved with or instigate in the community; transcript of marks.
-  NLC Foundation application, deadline May 30.





## NLC Foundation Entrance Award

-  Full-time student in any program other than a Dual Credit program at any campus.
-  15 \$1,000 awards (10 for Sep intake, five for Jan/Feb intake)
-  Attending NLC for the first time; Dual Credit graduates eligible if enrolling in a program other than their Dual Credit program.
-  NLC Foundation application, deadline May 30 (Sep intake high school students), Jun 30 (Sep intake adult students), Nov 30 (Jan/Feb intake); description (approximately 300 words) of planned program and future career goals.





## Paul Dampier Career and College Preparation (CCP) New Student Award

-  Full-time CCP adult student at any campus.
-  Two \$1,000 awards.
-  Registered in the fall semester; financial need.
-  NLC Foundation application, deadline Sep 20; essay of approximately 300 words detailing planned program and career goals and financial need.





## Shell Canada Entrance Award





-  Northeastern BC resident enrolled full-time in the Sep intake of Oil and Gas Field Operations or Power Engineering and Gas Processing.
-  Two \$2,000 awards (1 for all students, 1 for Aboriginal students)
-  Preference to high school applicants.
-  NLC Foundation application, deadline Sep 20; must indicate how award will benefit educational goals.

## TransCanada Pathway to Pipeline Readiness Trades Bursary

-  Full-time student enrolled or enrolling in one of the following program areas: Carpentry, Commercial Transport Technician; Electrician; Heavy Mechanical Trades; Industrial Instrumentation; Millwright; Plumbing; Professional Cook; Welding.
-  Varies depending on need (\$500 - \$750).
-  Resident of Northern BC; financial need; include letter outlining education and career goals.
-  TransCanada Pathway to Pipeline Readiness Trades Bursary Application; continuous deadline.

## Northern First Nations Health Partnership Committee Health and Wellness Award

-  Aboriginal student enrolling in a health related program.
-  TBD @ \$500
-  Financial Need; letter (approx. 300 words) describing their financial need, past achievements, and career and educational goals. The applicant's career and educational goals should reflect an interest in the health and well being of First Nations and Aboriginal Peoples in northern British Columbia.
-  NLC Foundation application, deadline Jun 30.
