RELATED POLICIES:

POLICY

The College recognizes that instructional staff may wish to maintain memberships in societies for their own professional standing.

PROCEDURE

The cost of membership fees for professional societies shall be the responsibility of the individual instructor, or of the Professional Development Committee.

In cases where College Administration deems that such membership is a mandatory job requirement, the cost of membership will be covered by the College.

The College may, where it deems warranted because of direct benefit to the College or its student population, purchase an institutional membership in an organization or association. This requires the approval of the President or Vice-President Finance & Administration.
