GRADING SECTION AND STUDY BLOCK ENROLMENT

English as a Second Language (EASL) courses are taught at four levels: Beginner, Pre-Intermediate, Intermediate and Advanced.

1. Semester-based enrolment

- Study face-to-face
- Fixed start dates in September, January, and April
- 12 – 15 weeks each level

2. Grading section and study block enrolment

- Study face-to-face
- Must register in a grading section and a study block

EASL Registration Deposit Information

- A registration deposit payment is required at the time of registration.
- The deposit amount is:

Domestic students	International students
\$275 or the total of Student & Instruction-Related fees, whichever is less	\$275

- Registration deposits are applied towards the total cost of tuition and fees.
- Refer to www.nlc.bc.ca/Registration/feepayment for information about drop penalties.
- Students with approved AUG funding may be exempt from registration deposit. Must be approved in writing on your student record by a Financial Aid Officer before registration; otherwise, registration deposit is required.

Payment for tuition and fees is due in full on the first day of classes.
