

Covid FAQ for students

Do I have to check in when I come to campus?

No, but you must complete a health self-assessment before coming on campus, and you must stay home when sick. We are not checking your temperature.

Do I have to wear a mask in the classroom?

Yes. When you are presenting and keeping a distance of at least two metres from others you may remove your mask.

However, some of you may be exempt from wearing a mask. (See *Exemptions* below.)

Can I take off my mask in the classroom while eating and drinking?

Yes. When you are done, you need to put your mask back on.

What should I do if I am unwell, and I am supposed to be writing a midterm exam?

There is no simple answer. This is a conversation between you and your instructor.

What happens if there is a confirmed case of Covid-19 in one of my classes? Does the whole class have to quarantine?

Northern Health is responsible for contact tracing and is responsible for letting people know.

Is working or meeting in small spaces safe? What about distancing protocols?

All mechanical heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems are designed, operated, and maintained in accordance with WorkSafeBC requirements and ASHRAE Standards for indoor air quality, and are working properly.

Keeping a distance of at least two metres from others will allow you to remove your mask.

Exemptions

What do I do if I believe I should be exempt?

You must see our access services coordinator, following our processes for any other accommodations. When granted, you will receive a letter acknowledging that you have been exempted from mask wearing.
