Payment Methods for Student Housing

The payment methods listed below can be used to pay student housing rent, deposits and/or tuition and fees.

Online payment (Touchnet)

Students can make payments online using the **Touchnet** web application. Payments are applied directly to the students account, so students can immediately see their account balance. **Touchnet** supports Visa, MasterCard, and Interac Online (for selected Canadian banks and credit unions).

To access **Touchnet**, Log into <u>Web Advisor</u> (alternately through the <u>myapps.nlc.bc.ca</u> portal), and select Make a Payment from the Students menu. This may take a minute as we are building a detailed look at the student account. Once in, you can review your account, and make a payment. Other features of **Touchnet** include the ability to give others permission to pay... without giving them your username and password!

Online banking

Most banks and credit unions allow payment directly from your bank to the College. To pay your rent for Student Housing with online banking, select **Northern Lights College** as the payee, and use your **Account Holder ID** number (also known as your Student ID number) at the top of your **Statement of Account** as the **account number**. (example: 0034567)

Please allow a minimum of two business days before NLC will have received and processed your payment.

In person

Payment may be made at any Campus Services Office during regular business hours. We accept cash, cheque, debit (Interac), Visa, and MasterCard. Students may also present Passport to Education or sponsorship letters.

Phone/email/fax/mail

Payment via credit card and over the phone, via fax, or by mail may be accepted.
