- 2. Acceptance of Q2 Financial Forecast: A request to vote was sent by email on September 17, 2021, to approve the 2021-2022 Quarter 2 Financial Forecast and to have the Board Chair sign the forecast confirmation, which will be sent to the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills and Training. A copy of the report and confirmation were distributed via email and were also posted on D2L. The deadline for voting was September 29, 2021.

The email advised that there hadn't been any significant changes from Quarter 1; Northern Lights College is still anticipating a small deficit of approx. \$171,000; that NLC is forecasting balanced budgets for 22/23, 23/24, and 24/25 as we continue to recover from COVID-19 and anticipate enrollment levels to continue to grow; and that the assumptions used during the forecast (which have not changed from the prior quarter) were outlined on page 9.
