*Please read this form carefully. Incomplete or late nominations forms will not be accepted.*

**DEADLINE: Nomination forms MUST BE submitted by email no later than 12:00 pm**

1. DOWNLOAD a Nomination form from the Student Governance website:  
[http://www.nlc.bc.ca/Student\\_Governance](http://www.nlc.bc.ca/Student_Governance)
2. **Fill in page one of the nomination form** and request valid endorsement by two students who are members of the campus you would like to represent (i.e. Dawson Creek). NOTE: A member may run as a candidate for up to two (2) official positions, but these cannot include both President and Vice president as stated in the NLCSA bylaws.
3. **Complete page two of the nomination form** (a) enter a brief **one-two paragraph biography** which states who you are and why you are running for an executive position, and (b) **insert your photo**. These will be shared for election purposes with eligible voters. Both pages of the nomination form must be complete and submitted by the deadline. Nominations without a biography and photo will be rejected.
4. **Submit both pages of the completed nomination form** to the Chief Electoral Officer by email [nlcsa@nlc.bc.ca](mailto:nlcsa@nlc.bc.ca) before the 12 PM deadline on April 22, 2026.

**NOTE:** Nominations are open to represent each of the Regional campuses: Chetwynd, Tumbler Ridge, Dawson Creek, Fort Nelson, Fort St. John, Atlin, Dease Lake, and Online. You may only run for an executive position at your declared home campus. A home campus is automatically defined as the campus where the majority of your courses take place.

If you wish to participate in a Student Council Branch different than your defined home campus, you must email a request that specifies your desire to: *change your Home Campus for the purposes of student association from: (identify your current home campus) to: (identify the new home campus) with your nomination form.*

5. Once nominations close, the **NLCSA Chief Electoral Officer will contact nominees via email** to confirm their candidacy.
6. **Campaign between April 23 and May 7, 2026.** Campaigning is on the candidate's own expense and time. Campaign guidelines will be provided to eligible candidates by email by the Chief Electoral Officer.
7. **Thursday, May 7, 2026, VOTE!** Electronic ballots will be sent to your current email on file the morning of May 7. Students will be able to submit their online **vote until 4PM Dawson Creek time that same day**. It is the student's responsibility to ensure their email address is accurate before electronic ballots are emailed.
