4. Plumbing Apprenticeship Training New Course – PLAT 300B Cross Connection Control

Cross Connection Control is a one-week course that is required for certification by the British Columbia Water and Waste Association (BCWWA). It is already offered in the Plumbing Level 3 Apprenticeship program but is also required for journeyman plumbers who have not yet received certification or individuals who need to recertify. Students wishing to enroll for this course would join the regular Plumbing Level 3 class for this component only, and must also be registered with the BCWWA. Some grammatical errors were corrected and 'final exam' information in the keys to success section was moved to the detailed course content section.
