

EDUCATION POLICYEDUCATION COUNCIL – STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES REMUNERATION

RELATED POLICIES:

POLICY

The College Board and Education Council recognize the value of student membership on the Education Council. In recognition of that value, all students elected to the Education Council will receive \$208.75 for the month in which they attend an Education Council meeting, to a maximum of ten (10) meetings per year. In the event of semester course attendance which may occasionally conflict with meeting dates and times, the Council encourages student members to participate in Education Council functions such as subcommittees, special meetings, executive positions or Educational Development Committee meetings. These meetings do not qualify for additional remuneration but provide a way for students to participate in the process for which they have been elected.

PROCEDURE

- Once a student is elected, the Education Council Clerk will make arrangements for students to be paid through the Payroll Department. Costs will be coded to the Education Council.
